PURPOSE: To offer CPR courses on the KU campus.

POLICY: Students, faculty, staff, and the general public are eligible to participate in CPR courses offered.

PROCEDURE:

1. If a person or group is interested in participating in a CPR class, contact HERO at 785-864-9570.
2. HERO provides certified Instructors to teach the courses. There is a fee for each course offered.
3. The CPR Instructor is responsible for communicating with participants about the enrollment process.
4. The CPR Instructor will complete HE-116-1 CPR Course Payment Form after the course has concluded.
5. HE-116-1 CPR Course Payment Form will be turned into the Business Office for billing and/or posting of payments.
6. Payment must be paid in full before a participant is given CPR certification card.
